**Sircomm Staff Reports:**

**Jerry:** Problems with Valley Emergency "chirping" have been looked into. The ACU in the back room was not correctly programmed when Valley Emergency was added. This was an operational program error tone in the 700 MHz demo system. Also, the Hagerman Tower is experiencing interference due to the number of wireless internet companies that have moved into the Valley. The wireless links "channel hop" frequencies when traffic is high, and they repeatedly land on our unlicensed frequency. The FCC cannot interfere being that SIRCOMM's frequencies are not licensed. John and Jerry are looking into licensing the frequencies to fix this issue.


**Kristy:** ILETS validations are becoming an issue with certain agencies. No representatives from those agencies were present at the meeting, therefore the item was removed from the agenda and those agencies will be dealt with on an individual basis. ILETS Security Analyst Joe Zelle was at SIRCOMM on Friday, May 7th to conduct a security audit. SIRCOMM had everything in order and no corrections or adjustments need to be made to the current security system in place at SIRCOMM.

**John:** Just a reminder to user agencies that SIRCOMM is the holder, but not owner, of records. If attorneys request an audio recording, dispatch is going to direct them to the agency that owns the record.


